



INSTRUCTION MANUAL

VORMA LIGHT

A powerful 900W sound activated lighting effect with 6 rich colours which send out 60 dancing coloured beams of light. The unit is plug and play and picks up ambient sound via its own internal microphone.

Other features are a sensitivity control and an internal fan to keep the unit cool.

II. Operational Instructions:


1. Unpack the carton to check if there is any damaged or missing parts when you receive the unit, call your local dealer if anything is found not in a normal condition.
2. Open the lid to install lamp. Keep the lamp untouched by hand and disconnect the unit from power while Re-lamping.
3. Use a clamp to hang the unit, please note secondary hanging point for safety chain.
4. Place the unit where there is efficient ventilation, away from any flammable objects or moisture.

5. Check that the rated power corresponds to the main supply.

III. Re-lamping:

1. Disconnect from power supply and cool down the unit before re-lamping.
2. Open the lid and replace the lamp.
3. Restore the lid.

IV. Caution:

1. For safety the following points should be carefully read and observed.
2. Ambient temperature should not exceed 35°C.
3. Disconnect from the power supply before opening or replacement of the lamp and fuse. Please be sure the lamp is cool before replacement!
4. To avoid electrical shock, do not touch any live parts when the unit is activated.
5. For maintenance, no spare parts are included with the unit, consult your local dealer.
6. Lens shall be changed if they have become visibly damaged to such an extent that their effectiveness is impaired, for example by cracks or deep scratches.
7. The lamp should be changed if it has become damaged or thermally deformed.
8. Do not cover the lamp!
9. Alternative precautions to switch off the device shall be taken if it is not easy to reach the socket. (e.g. additional disconnection device)
10. For installation in public places, please consult an approved electrician.
11. This unit must be earthed. 
12. Do not block fan or exhaust vents.
